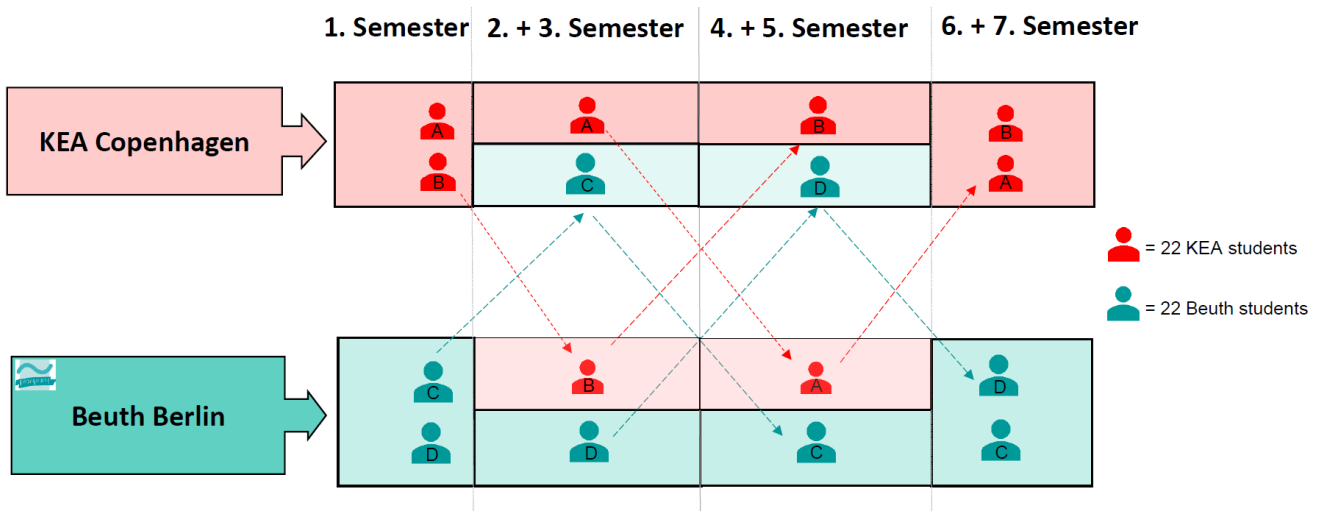

Student Buddy System

Students from both colleges will be partnered up with one another in a “buddy system” to facilitate the process of visiting students settling into their new academic and social environments (see diagram):



Those twenty-two students from Beuth who study at KEA in the second and third semester  will be partnered with twenty-two KEA-students in Copenhagen . Subsequently these students will spend the fourth and fifth semester together in Berlin. Accordingly those twenty-two students from KEA who study at Beuth in the second and third semester  will be partnered with twenty-two Beuth-students in Berlin . Subsequently these students will spend the fourth and fifth semester together in Copenhagen.

Beyond studying together the Buddy-teams, if necessary, help each other out e.g. registering for modules, solving administrative problems or managing day-to-day challenges, especially in cases where the respective mother tongue is helpful. Spending two years together students will thus be able to establish a sustainable network for the future.
